- New Program
  - The entire staff attended a training course on the new computer-coding program from Prenda. This computer coding class will be offered on Fridays from 4-5. Corrales is the first library in New Mexico to offer this class. There are four notebook computers available for student use in the library. Students can also access the program from home.
- There is a new AC/Heating unit for the YA room. It is a smart unit that can adjust according to the temperature.
- Bids are being taken to repair the interior stucco in the library and paint the porch area. The last of the county bond money will be used for this project.
- Next Friday, Edwina will meet with other Sandoval County Librarians to discuss what to request in the next County bond cycle.
- In February there will be a new Writers Workshop in the library presented by Renee Clifton.
- HomeTown Reads is now linked on the library's website. The Corrales Writing group will have a program at the library on how other Corrales authors can sign up along with a book reading from their latest collection.
- Nora Scherzinger was nominated to the Library Board and will be on the council's agenda next week.
