- C. The Father's day concert has made additional progress. The Village has waived the Park fee, but a noise permit has yet to be approved. Two bands are scheduled; hours are set (5-8 pm). No alcohol will be permitted. Corporate sponsorship is also being pursued.
- D. The two children's PC computers will soon be replaced by two "Literacy Stations" which will provide an improved educational data base.
