## **Library News**

We are keeping a count on computer users on the Gates computers. In February, there were a total of 638 computer users signed in.

There were 3,024 hits on the Library's website during the month of February.

During February, the Sandoval Digital Library had 480 items checked out by 130 patrons. There were 62 holds on items checked out in the system. The Racketeer by John Grisham was the most requested title in February. Currently, there are 1,954 titles in the collection.
