

## RFP 23-003 Questions and Answers #2

Question 1. The RFP mentions subsurface hydrology as one of the technical disciplines desired. What types of projects, studies, or investigations are you anticipating might be needed under this specialty?

Answer: The Village of Corrales may use subsurface hydrology including but not limited to hydrology for design and installation of Village owned wells, design of flood runoff retention ponds for ground water recharging, for the design and installation of culverts and installation of pipes for the drainage of previous open drain areas.

Question 2. Do you anticipate multiple contracts being awarded, or is it your intent to award an on-call contract to only one firm?

There will be one contract awarded for this RFP for one firm to act as on-call engineer for the Village.
