Revolutionary New Product to be Made in Corrales

Mayor Scott Kominiak and Village Councilors have reached an agreement with the Goggle corporation to locate production facilities for its new product, the Actual Reality Headset, in the "NCOD" area of Corrales's Far Northwest Sector. The plant is expected to employ 500 workers and be a huge boost for local GRT revenues. The agreement was reached between Village leaders and the company's Executive Vice President of Locational Services, Loof Lirpa, over mimosas in a secret meeting held early Friday morning.

"We are pleased to have reached this landmark agreement with Village Leadership," Lirpa said in a joint press release. "We will be employing some very exciting new environmental technology in this project. While the facility will use di-hydrogen monoxide in its process, with the resulting above CO2 emissions will be pumped via a large above ground duct or pipe into the Trees of Corrales farm. Large fans will distribute the emissions to the trees, which thrive on the substance."

In exchange for an incentive package that includes major tax incentives, monetary incentives (the Village will guarantee industrial revenue bonds for the Goggle Company), and donations of land and water rights by the Village, the Goggle Company will fund and construct a new nature park within the Corrales Bosque. The Bio Park will have a Bird Preserve, Butterfly Pavilion, and a Coyote Adoption Center to keep nature and the protection of the animals in the forefront of community standards. To accommodate Goggle management, the company will also be funding a new Corrales Regional Heliport to be located behind Corrales Elementary School.
