## **Library News**

We are keeping a count on computer users on the Gates computers. In February, there were a total of 700 computer users signed in.

There were 2,207 hits on the Library's website during the month of February.

Planning for a new automation system for the library is continuing. Biblionix, a vendor in Texas, is the top choice by the library staff for ease of use for volunteers and low annual fees. The project will be funded with the 2006 Sandoval County bond. The migration should begin in March.

Edwina submitted a grant proposal with Intel for the summer reading program. She was notified that the library would receive a \$6,000 grant. Congratulations to Edwina for a successful proposal.

Bob Serier, a local wood worker, is designing display shelves to go on the wall behind the circulation desk. These shelves will feature library programming and featured "Staff Pics".
