Librarian's Report

- Carla invited one of the assistant librarians, Laura Creech, to explain the new technology classes the library is offering. Information shared included:
 - There are two types of classes. One for a larger group of approximately 10-15 people. First class was on how to download ebooks etc into various devices. Next class will focus on library databases.
 - The other class is a small group of no more than 4 people. This class will be on general computer skills and is designed, via preliminary interviews with clients, to provide individual help according to the client's knowledge of computers.
 - Laura is also updating the library's Facebook page including suggestions from all staff.
 - o Carla reported on the following Library Programs
 - Edwina's ukulele class is going very well with a group that includes seniors to school aged children.
 - Carla reported that Edwina is working on the Summer Reading Program lineup.

Corrales Future Fund

- Carla report that she applied to the Corrales Future Fund for the monies to repair the library's roof (flat portion only) and to re-stucco various sections of the library. \$25,000.00 was granted and will be distributed to FOCL for work on this project. Total project cost is approximately \$32,000.00. FOCL will also be assisting by funding part of this project.
- Carla note that the current flat roof portion is at least 15 years old.

Library Website

- Carla reported that a committee has been formed to develop a new website for the library.
- FOCL will be funding the design. Laura Creech has been hired as the designer outside of her library hours to develop the website.
- The committee has a mix of members including a board member, Milton Strauss, a volunteer and a patron along with Carla and Laura.
